



NOTICE OF INTENT TO CIRCULATE PETITION

Government Code Section §56700.4 states that:

- a) Before circulating any petition for change of organization or reorganization, the proponent shall file with the Executive Officer a Notice of Intention that shall include the name and mailing address of the proponent and a written statement, not to exceed 500 words in length, setting forth the reasons for the proposal. The notice shall be signed by a representative of the proponent.
- b) After the filing required pursuant to subdivision (a), the petition may be circulated for signatures. [Per Government Code Section §56705 all signatures must be gathered within 6 months of the date of the first signature. The petition must be submitted to the Executive Officer within 60 days after the date of the last signature affixed to the petition.]
- c) Upon receiving the notice, the executive officer shall notify affected local agencies.
- d) The notice requirements of this section shall apply in addition to any other applicable notice requirements.
- e) This section shall not apply to any petition signed by landowners if all parcels within the affected territory are vested under the same ownership.
