## MUNICIPAL SERVICE REVIEW (MSR) AND SPHERE OF INFLUENCE STUDY (SOI) FOR THE GARCIA BEND COUNTY SERVICE AREA #9

The Draft Municipal Service Review (MSR) for the Garcia Bend County Service Area (CSA) #9 will be available for public review beginning September 19, 2018 at the office of the Yolo LAFCo and online at www.yololafco.org. On the basis of the Municipal Service Review and in accordance with Government Code Section 56425(g), staff has reviewed the agency's Sphere of Influence (SOI) and recommends that a SOI Update is not necessary at this time.
